**Franz Schubert 1797-1828**

A Schubert Suite

Norfolk born Chris Allen was a clarinetist and wind teacher in Bedfordshire until retiring in 2009. This is an arrangement for the Bedfordshire string orchestras of string orchestra of some very well known pieces by Schubert. First is the Andante start of the slow movement of Schubert's A minor (D804) String Quartet (Rosamunde). This is followed by a Waltz and the arrangement finishes with the first section of Schubert's first of three Marche Militaires (D733) for piano four hands.

**Arcangelo Corelli 1653 - 1713**

Arr. Sir John Barbirolli

Concerto for Oboe and Strings

Arcangelo Corelli was a distinguished Italian violinist mostly associated with Rome, who popularised the violin concerto and wrote particularly fine (and difficult) Concerto Grossi for string orchestras. This is a delightful arrangement of some of Corelli's themes by Sir John Barbirolli, the renowned British conductor, for his wife the eminent oboist Evelyn Rothwell. Before conducting full time, notably as the conductor of the Halle Orchestra from 1943 - 1970, Sir John was a fine cellist with many recordings existing of his expert playing.

**Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart 1756 - 1791**

Arr. Charles Woodhouse

Three Divertiment Movements

Three movements from Kv 131 Allegretto, Kv 252 Andante and Kv 205 Presto. Wolfgang Mozart, apart from being a fine pianist, was also a fine violin and viola player and his intimate knowledge of the nature of string instruments supports the fabulous quality of his writing for strings. He was still willing aged 33 to perform on the viola in Dresden the premiere of his Eb Divertimento Kv 563 (a very challenging string trio), alongside the top Viennese cellist virtuoso Anton Kraft (solo cellist in Haydn's Esterhazy Orchestra) and Anton Teyber, a fine violinist and Kapellmeister in Dresden.
